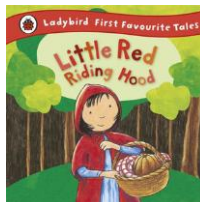
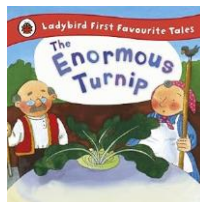
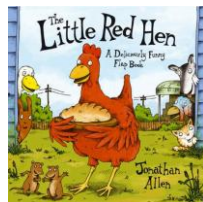


Dunmore Primary School

Themes for this term	Specific Learning
