Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the new school year. We hope that you all had a lovely summer break and that you are ready for a hardworking and exciting school year. We have many interesting and exciting opportunities planned before Christmas, as detailed below.

An overview of our term	
Geography We will be finding out about the Caribbean. We will be looking at where these islands are, what the landscape and climate is like and comparing life there with the UK. If you have any links to the Caribbean please let us know as we'd love to learn more from you.	Science In Science, we will be focusing on rocks and soil. We will study different types of rock, their properties, use and absorbency- as well as what soil is made of and how fossils are formed.
English In English, we will be reading adventure stories linked to pirates and The Caribbean. We will be writing character and setting descriptions and then, move on to creating our own adventure stories.	Maths This term in Maths, we will be beginning with a focus on Place Value and then move on to Addition and Subtraction.
Guided Reading will be taught daily in groups. SPaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar) will be taught discretely with weekly spelling tests.	We will continuing with TTRS and also have weekly times table tests.
Art We will be using different art techniques as well as media to create self portraits and lots of exciting artwork based on the Caribbean.	Computing Identifying that digital devices have inputs, processes, and outputs, and how devices can be connected to make networks.
PSHE Our PSHE focus will be (Being Me in My World) 'Who am I and how do I fit?'	French In French, we will be practising basic greetings and names.

In R.E, we will be looking at the question 'How and why do people worship?' We will consider the way that multiple people live their lives. Having a focus question leads to great discussions.	We will be focusing on developing our ball skills. We will specifically be looking at the rules and skills used in tag rugby.
