P.E.


 Ball skills: throwing, catching, dribbling, kicking, passing, shooting and defending.

We will reading a range of adventure stories this term including stories about Mungo. He gets up to all kinds of mischief!




In our writing we will be focusing on:

- Writing labels and captions
- Writing our own adventure story
- Writing a book review
- Using full stops, capital letters and question marks correctly.
- **Using a range of adjectives** to enhance the content of our writing.
- Can you write a Christmas shopping list?
 Can you help write your family's Christmas cards and gift labels? Could you write the address on an envelope?

Maths

- Continue to learn and solidify our knowledge of 2s, 5s, and 10 times tables
- Begin to learn 3s and 4s times tables.
- Recognise all number bonds to 10 and 20.
- Adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers using a number line.



- Understand how to use **arrays** and **number line** to solve multiplication questions.
- Understand how to use counting and number lines to solve division questions.
- Understand that multiplication is
 commutative (can be done in any order) eg
 5 x 2 = 2 x 5
